7-Day Budget Itinerary

This is a suggested 7-day itinerary for skiing in Japan, focusing on affordability and maximizing your time on the slopes.

Note: Costs are estimates and can vary.

Day 1: Arrival in Tokyo & Transfer to Hakuba

- Arrive at Narita (NRT) or Haneda (HND). Take the train to Hakuba (approx. 4 hours).
 - o Estimated Cost: ¥8,000

Day 2: Hakuba Skiing - Happo-One

- Ski at Happo-One, known for its varied terrain. Consider a lesson.
 - Estimated Cost: Lift pass ¥6,000, Lesson ¥5,000

Day 3: Hakuba Skiing - Cortina & Norikura

- Explore Cortina and Norikura. Backcountry options available (hire a guide!).
 - Estimated Cost: Lift pass ¥5,500, Guide ¥10,000 (split between group)

Day 4: Travel to Nozawa Onsen

- Take the train/bus to Nozawa Onsen (approx. 4 hours). Enjoy the onsen (hot springs).
 - Estimated Cost: ¥4,000

Day 5: Nozawa Onsen Skiing

- Ski at Nozawa Onsen. Explore the village.
 - Estimated Cost: Lift pass ¥5,000

Day 6: Travel back to Tokyo

- Take the train/bus back to Tokyo (approx. 5 hours). Enjoy dinner in Shinjuku.
 - o Estimated Cost: ¥8,000, Dinner ¥3,000

Day 7: Departure

- Depart from Narita (NRT) or Haneda (HND).
 - Estimated Cost: Airport transfer ¥3,000
